## GRASS HEIGHT

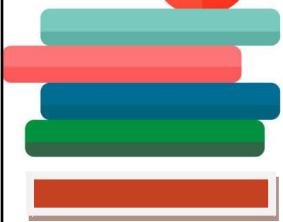

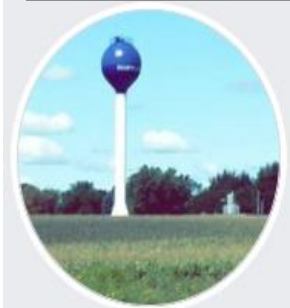


### UPCOMING CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS
