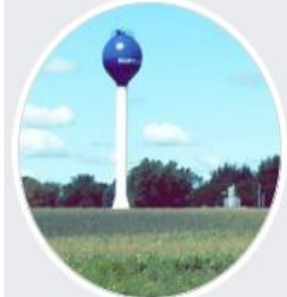


### UPCOMING CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS
