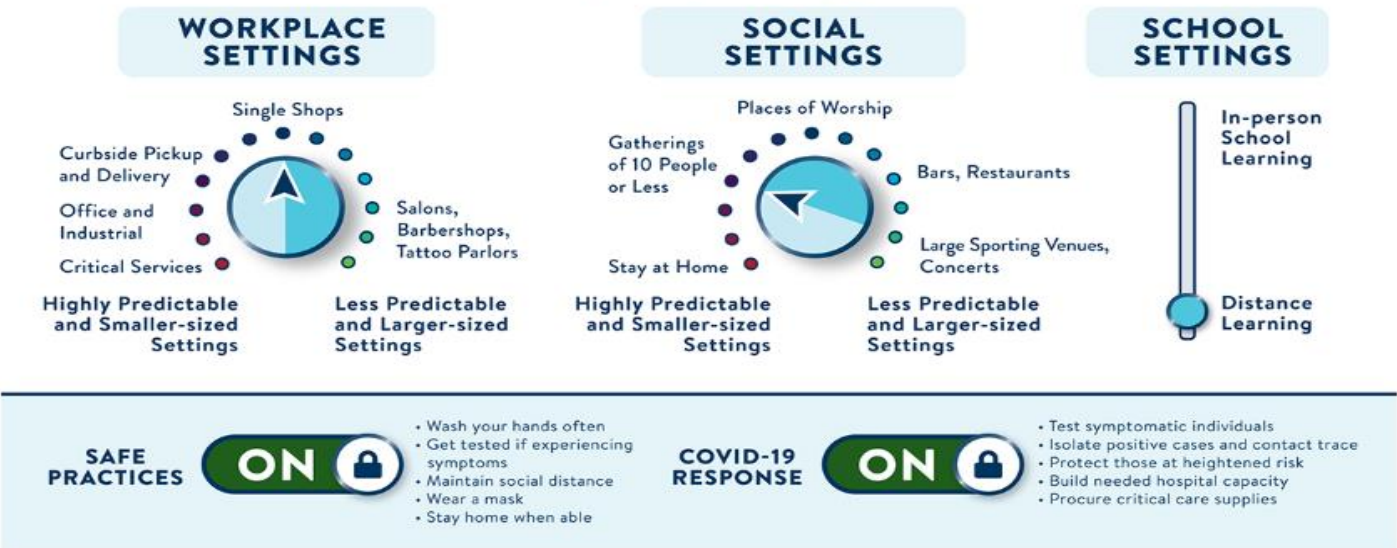

## CHAIRS UP FOR ELECTION

On November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 three council chairs and the mayor position will be up for election. Anyone who would like to be listed on the ballot for these positions must contact the City Office **before** July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020. The council chairs that will be up for election are currently held by Council Member Linda Pederson, Council Member Nancy Toot, and Council Member Warren Johannsen. The mayor position is currently held by Mayor Kelly Routh. The council chair is a four year term while the mayor position is a two year term. Warren Johannsen's chair will be a special election; he was appointed to fill a vacancy and the election will be for the remaining two years of his term.

## MAIL BALLOT PRECINCT

The City of Hartland has passed resolution #2020-01 declaring mail balloting as the selected method used for the Primary Election on August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020, with the only polling place being the office of the Freeborn County Auditor. All registered voters will receive more information regarding this type of voting from the County. At this time, this resolution is intended to only be in effect for the primary election. The council will revisit the polling place issue for the general election in November at a later date.
