TEMPORARY CLOSURE TO THE BRUSH DUMP SITE

Due to issues with illegal dumping at the brush site, it is closed until further notice. Updates can be found on the City of Hartland, MN Facebook page as they become available.

FIRE SAFETY

Summer nights are great to spend around the fire pit, but with the dry periods we have been having this year, the City would like to remind everyone to enjoy your recreational fires responsibly. Steps to have a safe fire include:

- *Contained within a fireproof border (natural rock, cement, brick, tile, blocks, ferrous metal)
- *No more than three foot diameter circle and three feet in height.
- *Burning only clean, dry wood. Prohibited burning materials include: oils, petroleum fuels, rubber, plastics, chemically treated materials, tires, shingles, building materials, etc.
- *An adult MUST be tending the fire at ALL times.
- *Extinguished **completely** before leaving the area unattended.
- *Be aware of Freeborn County burn bans as they happen in dry weather. Follow the DNR's updates at the link below:
