-The water plant siding still needs to be repaired. The City will ask for an extension on the period that it needs to be fixed because no contractors have returned any bids yet. Current deadline is December 15<sup>th</sup> 2022.

-The City will keep the old city truck as back up and for hauling/plowing as needed. Sale of the truck may be discussed in the future.

### City Clerk Updates:

-The 2022 General Election will be held November 8<sup>th</sup> in the Fire Hall, polls will be open from 7 am – 8 pm.

-The Hartland Pub's liquor license will expire December 31<sup>st</sup> 2022. The clerk has the renewal in progress and the City will collect a total of \$1,340 for all of the various licenses: off sale, on sale, and Sunday sale.

-Tornado clean up costs will be paid out of the General Fund instead of the Water Fund.

-All of the houses that have had City Ordinance violations are working on their issues and will not be assessed any fines.
