- No new progress on April issues, Kelly will reach out to Bolten-Menk on water plant siding and Andy is still dealing with the roof on the old pump house
- Todd Eaton will be contacted about evacuating his building space and removing his vehicles from the restaurant area
- Roof Top Solutions donated a new roof to the bus stop

City Clerk Updates:

- Resolution 2022-02 for the demolition of the damaged buildings was passed, Molly motioned, Warren 2nd
- request for bids for demolition officially opens and will be published on June 9th in the Star Eagle and will be on the City website as well
- bid process will close July 7th at 11:00 and attorney will be present at city hall to insure we pursue the proper bid
- \$10,000 grant was received from SMIF for tornado damage
- an additional \$10,000 grant from SMIF will be applied for to use towards reestablishing our Central Park if granted
