PERMIT/LICENSE DUE DATE REMINDER

PAY YOUR WATER BILL ONLINE

The City of Hartland has implemented an online payment option for water bills. Go to hartlandmn.com and look for the green "\$ Doxo Bill Pay" button in the top right corner. You will be prompted to create a login with your information, which will be stored for future payments to make the process quick and easy. Payments with cards do have a fee, but direct payment with banking information is free. Some information you will need to create your account:

*Name of account holder.

*Service Address.

*Last 6 digits of account number, found on your bill. Ex) 000-00-0

You will need to know how much you would like to pay each time you login, you will only be able to see your account balance on your paper bill received in the mail.

*Payments may take up to 4 business days to post, please be aware of the due date when making online payments.

*At this time, online payment is for water bills **only**. We still accept cash, check, money order sent via mail or placed in the drop box at the Community Center.

MOWING

Summer is here and in full swing! Some friendly reminders about yard maintenance: City Ordinance #50 does not allow any growth of weeds, grass, or other rank vegetation to an excessive height, or an accumulation of dead weeds, grass, or brush. Also, as mowing season starts, please remember not to mow, rake, or dump grass clippings and leaves onto the street. This can lead to sewer issues, and is very dangerous to motorists. Brush and yard waste can be brought to the City Dump Site but please remember no other dumping is permitted. Illegal dumping will lead to a \$500 fine.
