SNOW PLOWING

The City will be enforcing strict towing and fining of vehicles that are left on the road after a plowable snow. Fines will be \$50 City fines, plus all applicable expenses from being towed. **Olson Excavating also reserves the right to bypass roads that have too many vehicles parked on them and leave said roads unplowed. Remind your neighbors that vehicles need to be moved for plows.**

Some SNOW reminders:

- You cannot push snow across the road or onto your neighbor's property.
- The boulevard needs to be cleared for plows, this is generally 10 feet to each side of the road.

CHRISTMAS LIGHTS

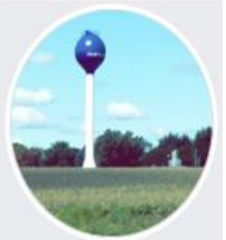
