Mayor Kelly Routh called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Motion to approve the agenda, minutes from the council meeting on July 11th, and the accounts payable was made by Molly, seconded by Warren; motion carried.

City Clerk Updates:

-Primary Election on August 9th, 2022. Voting will take place in the Fire Hall.

Council Concerns:

-2 bids were received for tornado demolition; Olson Excavating submitted the lowest bid at \$297,000 for removal of the buildings and \$27,000 for installation of foundations on each lot of the old post office building and cafe. Motion to accept the bid and pass the accepting resolution made by Warren, seconded by Megian; motion passed. Resolution #2022-03 passed accepting the bid submitted by Olson Excavating. Notice of Award given to Brandon Flatness.

-The council would like to put a committee together to oversee the rebuilding of the areas damaged from the tornado in December 2021. Notices will be posted in the newsletter, Facebook, and the Post Office.

-The council is considering hiring Vatos Lawn Care to take care of delinquent residents' lawn care that is not compliant with City Ordinance. Motion to hire Vatos Lawn Care was made by Megian, seconded by Molly; motion carried. Vatos Lawn Care will take care of all noncompliant lawn care.
