

Special Meeting May 12th, 2022

Acting Mayor Molly Sickels called the special meeting to order at 6:30pm solely for the purpose to discuss and vote on the City accepting ownership of the building owned by Donald Klyberg located at 509 Broadway St. Hartland, MN 56042 and therefore paying the first half of the 2022 property taxes. This special meeting was called to be in compliance with the League of MN Cities, Meetings of City Councils. A recording of this meeting will be kept on file with the City Clerk.

Public Comments were discussed on what were the plans if any, that would indicate what the city would do with this property. At this time, it is unknown.

JR Henderson discussed having either more barricades up in that back alley or signs stating “no thru street”, warning people not to drive through that alley. Megian suggested that this subject would be added as an agenda item to the June 6th meeting.

Council Member Warren Johannsen made a motion to pay taxes on the listed property; seconded by council member Megian Bell. Council members Molly Sickels and Jackie Schlaak cast affirmative votes to pay taxes on the listed property.

With unanimous votes for the motion among members that cast votes, the motion passed; the City will take ownership of the building located at 509 Broadway St. in Hartland and pay the first half of the 2022 property taxes.

Megian Bell made a motion to end the Special Meeting, Warren Johannsen seconded. Meeting ended at 6:40pm.
