UPDATE FOR CITY BRUSH DUMP SITE

Due to ongoing issues of illegal dumping at the brush site, most often done by people from out of town, the City will be changing the brush dump procedures beginning in the Spring of 2022. The site will be locked with a Master Lock and keys will be available for purchase by local residents only. At the time of this newsletter, the cost of each key will be \$10*, which is the cost to the City to have copies made. *This price is subject to change due to price changes at the actual time of having the key copies made.
