ONLINE WATER BILL PAYMENT NOW AVAILABLE

The City is happy to announce that we are partnering with Doxo Online Payment providers to accept water bill payments online. Beginning with the May 25th water bill, there is now an option on our website to make a payment with a credit card, debit card, or banking information. There is a fee associated with payments made via credit or debit card; this fee goes to Doxo, not the City. **Payments made with banking information do not have any fees.** You will not be able to see your current balance when logging into the Doxo extension, you will still need your paper stub to know how much to pay.

How to make an online water bill payment:

- 1.) Go to hartlandmn.com
- 2.) In the upper right-hand corner of the home page, you will see a green box linking to "\$ Doxo Bill Pay."
- 3.) With your first payment, you will be prompted to create an account, you will need to know your water bill account number, which you can find on your bill.
- 4.) It will ask you how much you would like to pay, you must reference your paper water bill to see your current balance. There is not a way for us to link your current balance to this website at this time.
- 5.) The City will receive your payment and post to your account within 1-2 business days.

This program can **only be used to pay for water bills**, not pet licenses, golf cart permits, or any invoice payments. Any payment made above your current water bill balance will be posted as a credit to your next bill.

CHANGE TO OFFICE HOURS

Beginning the week of May 24th, the City Clerk office will be open **Monday evenings from 5-7 pm and Tuesday afternoons from 11 am – 1 pm.** The office will now be closed Wednesday evenings.

REMINDER TO LICENSE PETS, GOLF CARTS

Pet licenses and golf cart permits are **due Wednesday June 16th.**

Spayed/neutered cats and dogs are \$5 per animal, \$30 per animal that is not fixed. **Limit 2 dogs and 2 cats per household.** Current vaccination records required.

Golf cart permits are \$15 each. Proof of current insurance required.

Penalties for unlicensed animals:	\$180 per animal
Penalties for unlicensed golf carts:	\$50 1 st offense, \$100 2 nd and every following offense

Please do not add license payments to your water bill payment. Separate payments are REQUIRED.
